Program Details:

1. Matched savings account
(2:1 match on savings up to a \$4,000 grant). Funds can be used for:
 - Home purchase
 - Small business
 - Post-secondary education
 - Retirement
2. Free classes and support sessions:
 - 10 hours of financial literacy classes (saving, budgeting, credit and investment)
 - 4-6 hours of goal specific training (ex: how to purchase a home)
 - Monthly roundtables on various topics (nutrition, parenting, etc.)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Live in **San Mateo** County
- Be a single female head of household (with at least 1 dependent 18 years or under)
- Have earned income and steady employment history for the past 2 years
- Limited net assets
- Analysis of credit history
- Gross income must be at or under 60% of Area Median Income (AMI)
